



Wohelo Uniform Information 2009

"The simplicity of camp is wonderful. Please remember, it is most common for girls to bring too much!"

We feel that the camp uniform is an important aspect of Wohelo and it has been a part of camp since 1907. Besides saving time every morning deciding what to wear, at Wohelo we like to get to know the person, not their clothing. All the campers and counselors wear appropriate uniform items all the time at camp. Twice a week (Sunday Sivad, and Council Fire or Frog's Frolic) the girls must wear the striped shirt, red jacket, blue shorts and white socks.

Uniform items are purchased through Maine Camp Outfitters. International orders are sent to Wohelo for campers' arrival. Maine Camp Outfitters will visit camp the first week and after mid-session for exchanges if needed.

Some uniform items are available at camp during the summer (especially swimsuits and bathing caps)

Rental uniforms are also available. Please complete and return the enclosed sheet for pickup on opening day.

The **REQUIRED UNIFORM** consists of the following.

3 Navy shorts - Wohelo Logo OR Plain Navy Shorts – with no logos or designs.
No cut-off jeans.

5 T-shirts - Of three types: - Striped (at least one)
- Navy-with Wohelo Bird
- White Long Sleeved – with Wohelo Bird

The shirts must be rented at camp or purchased through Maine Camp Outfitters. Other shirts are not acceptable. Wohelo Tank top is appropriate as an extra shirt.

1 Red Jacket (fleece or chamois)– These can be rented, bought from camp, or purchased through Maine Camp Outfitters. Our rental supply is mostly smaller sizes.

1 or 2 Scarlet red bathing suit - **Plain** scarlet red one-piece suit- please no striping or designs. Having two suits allows for one to dry.

Name Tape/Labels- Maine Camp Outfitters will SEW in their own labels for free on orders before May 1st (\$100 minimum order). We highly recommend this for orders through them. The Permanent Ink stamps available in the catalog are also useful for all clothing items and can be brought to camp. Ironed in name tapes sometimes come off in the hot camp dryer – we recommend sewing them on or using the rubber stamp. Unlabeled clothes are difficult to return to owners during the summer.



Trunk- A rigid trunk is an important part of packing and keeping clothes organized during the summer. A high quality trunk can survive many summers at camp and even be passed down to the next generation of campers. We have enclosed mailers for two trunk companies, and Maine Camp Outfitters also sells trunks. When ordering from C&N or Texas Case specify you are ordering for Camp Wohelo for a discount or personalization offer. We have found that height less than 14” is more manageable for the girls and can slide under the beds nicely. The inexpensive, “Wal-Mart”, trunks with cardboard laminate tops will work for the summer but are likely to be damaged during the camp season and please be sure to box them to ship. (We will box the trunks at camp for the shipping home).

Camp Store – When possible campers should arrive with personal necessities enough for the whole summer. We do sell some toiletries, (toothbrush, shampoo, etc.), insect repellent, stationery and stamps, Wohelo water bottles, swim caps, batteries, and most items that campers need to replace during the summer. These purchases are deducted from your \$300 store account.
